



# Create Your Own Costume!



**Each day during camp, you will get to pretend to be a person from another time.**

**If you enjoy dressing up, you may be able to create a costume from clothes you have around your house.**

**Feel free to come to camp dressed in your costume or put one on whenever you feel like dressing up and using your imagination!**

## **Monday - 1777**

**To dress like a Colonial boy:** You can use sweatpants pulled up to your knee for britches, a white dress shirt, a vest and boots.

**To dress like a Colonial girl:** You can use a long skirt, a white shirt, and a shawl (small blanket folded into a triangle and draped over your shoulders).

## **Tuesday & Wednesday - Victorian Era (1830 - 1900)**

**To dress like a Victorian boy:** You can use sweatpants pulled up to your knee for britches or dress pants, a dress shirt, a tie if you have one and dress shoes.

**To dress like a Victorian girl:** You can wear a long dress and apron.

## **Thursday & Friday - Early-20th Century (1920 - 1940)**

**To dress like an early 20th-century boy:** Dress pants or shorts, a collared shirt (button up or polo), suspenders, baseball cap & sneakers.

**To dress like an early 20th-century girl:** A collared dress (knee length) or a knee-length skirt and collared shirt and flats. Add a ribbon or bow in your hair if desired.
