

DRAWING GAME INSTRUCTIONS

While this game is historical, you might find that you have played it in school! Even if you are by yourself, you can still play it. By folding a paper in three parts, you will draw a head, a body, and a bottom- without seeing the other parts- to create some kind of monster.



- Step 1: Fold a piece of paper into three equal sections, just like you would a letter.
- Step 2: Starting on one end of the paper, without looking at the other two, draw a head of a monster.
- Step 3: Flipping your folded paper to the middle section, without looking at the other two, draw the body of a monster. This body does not have to match the head you just drew. The more different it is, the more fun it is!
- Step 4: Flipping to the final section left, without looking at the other two sections, draw the bottom of your monster.
- Step 5: When done, unfold the whole paper and look at the monster you have created!

If you have someone at home to play this with, you each will fold your own piece of paper and start by drawing the head of the monster. You can switch papers and, without looking at the other person's head, draw what you think the middle of the monster should be! If you have a third person to draw with, you can switch papers a third time and draw a monster bottom.
