


# Roleplaying: School

## Arithmetic

Have your student answer the following math problems out loud!

- **Jon had 2 cents and his brother gave him 2 more. How many cents did he then have?**  
Since Jon had 2 cents and his brother gave him 2 more and since 2 plus 2 is four; therefore Jon had 4 cents, Ma'am.
- **Mabel gave me 5 apples and William gave me 4 apples. How many apples did I then have?**  
Since Mabel gave me 5 apples and William gave me 4 apples and since 5 plus 4 is 9; therefore, I had 9 apples, Ma'am.
- **Geoffrey had 2 cows and he purchased 5 more cows. How many cows did he then have?**  
Since Geoffrey had 2 cows and he purchased 5 more cows and since 2 plus 5 is 7; therefore, he then had 7 cows, Ma'am.
- **Susan gave 3 cents for some nuts and 4 cents for some candy. How many cents did she pay for both?**  
Since Susan gave 3 cents for some nuts and 4 cents for some candy and since 3 plus 4 is 7; therefore, she paid 7 cents for both, Ma'am.

- **A lemon cost 3 cents and a pineapple costs 8 cents. How much did both cost?**  
Since a lemon costs 3 cents and a pineapple costs 8 cents and since 3 plus 8 is 11; therefore they both cost 11 cents, Ma'am.
