



Create Your Own Costume!

This week, you will be roleplaying a child growing up in 1919 just after World War I or 1943 during World War II. Part of roleplaying is dressing like your character.

During our Zoom call on Monday, we will talk about what you can find around your house to create an outfit similar to what your character may have worn.

If you are eager to get started or you missed the call, here are some options:

To dress like an early 20th-century boy:

1. Dress pants or shorts with knee socks
2. A collared shirt (button up or polo)
3. Suspenders
4. Baseball cap or flat cap (“Newsboy” cap)
5. Dress shoes or converse sneakers.

To dress like an early 20th-century girl:

1. A collared dress (knee length) or a knee-length skirt
2. Collared shirt (if wearing a skirt)
3. Flats or Saddle Shoes
4. Add a ribbon or bow in your hair if desired.
