

Decorate your own Binoculars

As we learned in camp, kids of all ages used binoculars to watch the sky and look out for enemy aircraft during WWII. They prepared by using spotter cards to learn what the enemy aircraft would look like. In the same spirit, campers get a chance to decorate and design a set of binoculars to use to explore the skies.



- Step 1: Gather the following materials:
 - Binoculars
 - Pencil to sketch
 - Markers to add color
- Step 2: Use your pencil to sketch any pictures, designs, or words you'd like to decorate your binoculars
- Step 3: Use your markers to add color to your sketches
- Step 4: Let the marker set and dry before using your binoculars
- Step 5: Use your newly decorated binoculars to explore the skies!
