

# Decorate a Pinwheel

Pinwheels, like the ones we know today, were invented in Boston in 1919. They are fun to make, decorate and play with. Take some time to make a fun design on your pinwheel. On Friday, we will put them together on our Zoom call.



- Step 1: Locate the following items from your camp kit:
  - Pinwheel (parts include straw, hexagonal paper, a white star, two plastic pieces).
  - Markers or crayons
- Step 2: Begin to decorate your pinwheel. You can:
  - Decorate just the insides
  - Decorate just the outside
  - Decorate the **WHOLE** thing!
  - Create a fun pattern for when it moves
