

# Make a Jigsaw Puzzle

As we learned, the Industrial Revolution gave wealthier people more leisure time- meaning they had more time for fun! One item that became really popular in the 1800s was the jigsaw puzzle. While jigsaw puzzles had been around, they were mainly puzzles of maps used to teach kids geography. Now, technology was making all kinds of puzzles, with different and fun pictures. People loved puzzles so much, libraries even carried them. You could take a puzzle out and return it when you were done.



- Step 1: Find the following items in your camp kit.
  - Blank Jigsaw Puzzle (when you take it out of the kit, try to leave it intact. Otherwise you will have to put it back together before you begin.)
  - Crayons, Markers, Colored Pencils
  - Pencil
- Step 2: Brainstorm what you want the design of your puzzle to be. It might help to even sketch it out on blank paper first.
- Step 3: Outline your design lightly on your puzzle in pencil. This will help you not make mistakes when you use something more permanent.
- Step 4: Finally, create your jigsaw puzzle using crayons, markers or colored pencils.
- Step 5: When done, take apart your puzzle and try to put it back together again!
