

Make Your Own Bee Garden

Materials

- 4 peat pellets
- Seeds
- Plastic container
- Plastic scoop
- Water (not in kit)



Instructions

1. Place your peat pellets into the plastic container.
2. Prepare them for the seeds by adding about $\frac{1}{8}$ cup of water to each pellet.
3. Once the pellets expand and have soaked up most of the water, use the scoop to push aside some dirt.
4. Plant 2-3 seeds in each pellet and then cover them up with a thin layer of dirt.
5. Place the cover on your container and leave it be for a few days.
6. Check your container often to make sure there is still enough moisture and to see when sprouting begins.
7. After the seeds sprout and are growing close to the top of the container, remove the top and place the container in a sunny area.
8. Use a spray bottle or a cup to water the plants. Don't let them dry out, but don't over water them either.

9. When the seeds have been growing for a few weeks, take them outdoors and plant them in a sunny space.

10. As they grow, observe if any bees are attracted to your plants.
