

# Make Your Own Butterfly Garden



## Materials from Kit

- Peat pot
- Dirt
- Seeds (variety of milkweeds to attract butterflies)
- Water
- Plastic wrap (optional) - not in kit

## Instructions

- Place most of the dirt into the pot
- Add enough water to moisten the soil (Be careful not to add too much or the pot will begin to disintegrate)
- Spread some seeds over the top
- Add the rest of soil on top of the seeds so they are covered about ¼ inch
- If you have plastic wrap at home, use it to tightly cover the top of the pot to simulate a greenhouse effect
- Once the plant begins to sprout, uncover the pot and leave it out in the sun
- Continue to water the plant so the soil stays moist (a spray bottle works well so you don't over water.)
- After a few weeks, you can plant your flower outside. You can leave it right in the pot when you plant as the peat pot will break down in the soil.

**★If you have any seeds left, try planting them directly in the ground or start them in a small pot.**
