

Make your own Terrarium

As we learned in camp, children and adults loved nature during the Victorian Era. They loved to bring things from nature into their houses when they had the chance. Today, we are going to make a craft using nature that could be used to decorate our own homes! It is called a terrarium, and is kind of like a snow globe, but it is decorated with items from nature!



- Step 1: Gather the following materials:
 - Plastic Dome with Base
 - Nature Items (some you collected yesterday, some came in your kit)
 - Glue
- Step 2: Begin to construct your terrarium by gluing your moss to the base.
- Step 3: Continue to arrange your terrarium using objects from your kit and objects you gathered outside. You will do this by continuing to glue items on top of the moss, or on top of each other. Remember, you want to make sure you don't design anything that won't fit under the dome when we put it on top!
- Step 4: It is best to wait to add your plastic animals until the very end so they do not get lost in any of the plants you glued in. Place them somewhere near the top as you finish your terrarium.
- Step 5: Once you have arranged your items and glued them down, gently put your terrarium dome on top and screw it in! You may want to let the terrarium dry before trying to put the top on.
