



# Learn to Play Woggabaliri

## Introduction

Woggabaliri is a traditional Australian game. The game was played mostly in the Bogan and Lachlan River areas. Traditionally, the ball used in the game would have been made from possum fur and was about 5 centimeters in diameter.

## Materials

- A ball (there is a small one in your kit, but try it with a soccer or volleyball if you have one)

## How to Play

- Players stand in a circle
- One player kicks the ball in the air
- The other players try to kick it (only one touch) before it hits the ground
- No player may kick the ball two times in a row
- The object of the game is to see how many times the ball can be kicked before it hits the ground
- If playing with more than one team of players, the team with the most consecutive kicks wins
